Rly to begin recruitment drive on Dec 15; Covid disclosure must

New Delhi, 11 December

The Railways on Friday said computer-based tests to fill 140,000 posts with the national transporter will be conducted following all Covid-19 protocols, including minimum travel time to centres for the 24.4 million candidates and mandatory use of face masks.

Candidates will have to sign a declaration saying they are fit to sit for the test.

“While it is not possible for candidates to provide a negative certificate for Covid, they will have to provide a declaration that they are fit to sit for the exam and are not Covid positive. The pro forma will be provided for the declaration,” Anand S Khati, director general, HR, Railway Board, said in a press briefing.

“On coming to the centre, a candidate will be tested with a thermometer. If the temperature is beyond the mandated limit,

the candidate's exam will be rescheduled. This is a matter of safety. Candidates have largely been accommodated either within their states or at centres that require minimum travel, specially for women applicants and divyangs,” Khati said.

The first round of the exams

will be held from December 15 to December 18. The next phase will be from December 28 till March 2021 tentatively, and the third round will be till the end of June 2021.

Links for downloading e-call letter will be made live four days prior to the exam date on

the official websites of all Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs). Communication regarding the next phases of recruitment will be released in due course, the statement said.

Khati said the Railways would be running special exam trains to cater to the travel requirements of candidates, wherever required and feasible. Chief secretaries of state governments concerned have also been requested to extend support of local administration to RRBs for conducting computer-based tests in secure and safe manner ensuring social distancing, he said. In computer-based tests, candidates are provided a link to familiarise themselves with a mock test before the actual exam.

There are no interviews in RRB examinations and selection of candidates is on merit only, he said. Khati said the entire process, from conducting of exams to handing over of appointment letters, will take around a year to complete.

Delhi HC stays QC order asking IAF to provide PM's foreign visits data

The Delhi High Court on Friday stayed the Central Information Commission (CIC) order directing the Indian Air Force (IAF) to provide information regarding Special Flight Returns-II, which contains details of the Prime Minister's entourage on his foreign trips.

Justice Navin Chawla said the information sought by the RTI applicant with regard to details of the ministry or department officials who accompanied the PM on a trip cannot be disclosed, but there was no harm in providing details of the number of passengers on flights. The court will hear the matter again on April 12.

Kolkata not to send CS, DGP to Delhi despite MHA summons

Kolkata, 11 December

A defiant West Bengal government on Friday decided not to send the state's chief secretary and police chief to New Delhi in compliance with Union Home Ministry's summons in the wake of a mob attack on BJP chief J P Nadda's convoy, the latest flashpoint between the state and the Centre.

Chief Secretary Alapan Bandopadhyay wrote to Home Secretary Ajay Bhalla, saying he has been directed to request to “disperse with the presence of the state officials” in the meeting convened on December 14, an obvious indication that he was just obeying the state government's order.

The MHA had on Friday summoned Bandopadhyay and DGP Virendra on December 14 for an explanation on the law and order situation in the state, following Governor Jagdeep Dhankhar's report on the attack on Nadda's convoy by alleged sup-

porters of the ruling TMC.

The top bureaucrat of the state said as requested by the Home Secretary on December 10, the state had indeed made elaborate arrangements for security.

“The incidents regarding Z-category protectees are already being examined at our end.

The West Bengal Police had provided a bulletproof car and a pilot to Shri J P Nadda, which was in addition to the escort (vehicle by state, personnel by CRPF) and PSOs (CRPF) he is entitled as a Z- category protectee,” Bandopadhyay wrote in the letter. Noting that three cases have been registered in connection with Thursday's violence, including two for vandalism, he said, seven persons have already been arrested.

West Bengal Governor Jagdeep Dhankhar on Friday said he had sent a report to the Centre in the backdrop of the attack. Pulling Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee up for her repeated remarks calling the BJP a party of outsiders, Dhankhar asked her to desist from such politics.

IIP grows...

Manufacturing sector activity posted growth for the first time since February, expanding by 3.5 per cent, while consumer durables sub-sector posted a double-digit expansion, mainly led by festival demand. Consumer durables, comprising mainly white goods and mobile phones, saw 17.6 per cent growth compared to 3.4 per cent growth in the previous month and a 18.9 per cent decline in October last year.

Consumer non-durables, comprising essential goods with a broadly non-elastic demand, grew by 7.5 per cent in October.

Construction goods production grew by 7.8 per cent during the month. The manufacturing category makes up 77 per cent of the index.

Farmers move SC...

In its petition in the Supreme Court, the Bharatiya Kisan Union has argued on behalf of the farmers that the farm laws were passed hastily by Parliament. “The implementation of the Acts in its current form will spell disaster for the farming community by opening a parallel market which is regulated and gives enough place for exploitation of the farmers,” it says.

“Without the agri produce market committee acting as a protective shield around the farmers, the market would ultimately fall to the corporate greed of multinational companies who are more profit-oriented and have no care for the condition of the farmers,” it adds. It further says the laws will corporatise agriculture. “If the Centre was agreeing to 12 of our 15 demands, that means the Bills are not right. Then why not destroy them? We had demanded one law on MSP (minimum support price) but they brought three Bills through Ordinance. Our protests will continue peacefully,” said Rakesh Tikait of the Bharatiya Kisan Union.

The government on its part has launched a massive outreach programme. A roster of Cabinet ministers is being drawn up to send them in batches to 700 districts in the country to tell farmers about the benefits of the laws. About 100 press conferences will also be held in various places all over the country. The BJP has also joined the campaign, with state presidents and in charges holding video conferences to fine-tune the outreach programme. Union Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar urged farmer union leaders to consider proposals sent to them to break the deadlock.

But the fault lines seemed to be spreading within the BJP. Film actor and former BJP MP Dharmendra tweeted, “I am extremely in pain to see the suffering of my farmer brothers. The government should do something fast.” The tweet was deleted within hours.

Underpaid...

These stories are echoed by nurses across the country. In the nine months, nurses have struck work in Delhi, Patna and Kolkata, among other states, to protest poor and unsafe working conditions and lack of compensation and compassion for those who have contracted the infection in the course of their work. To date, over 50 nurses have lost their lives to Covid, according to estimates of the Trained Nurses' Association of India (TNAI), one of the largest and oldest nurses' unions in India.

“Compared to doctors, the fatality rates among nurses are low,” says Roy George, president of the TNAI. This is probably because by the time Covid patients are admitted in hospitals where nurses come in contact with them, not only are safety protocols already in place but the patients themselves are mostly at the fag end of their infective phase. “But unfair working conditions and employment practices have made their lives hell.”

Hospitals, especially in states worst affected by Covid-19 like Telangana, Maharashtra and Delhi, have been overwhelmed by patients, which has resulted in longer, harder and more hazardous working hours for nurses.

Pune-based Support for Advocacy and Training to Health Initiatives (SATHI) released a survey it conducted on 367 nurses with the help of several nurses' organisations in Maharashtra this week. In the survey, 76 per cent reported being overworked; 65 per cent said they could not get leaves sanctioned during this period; and 174 per cent reported working double shifts. Yet, few, other than a handful of large private hospitals in metros, have offered any financial incentives to nurses.

“Forget a Covid allowance,” says Siju Thomas, joint secretary of the Indian Professional Nurses Association (IPNA), “many private hospitals have cut nurses' salaries by over 30 per cent.”

Unfair salary structures in private hospitals have been a longstanding issue for nurses. The TNAI had petitioned for higher salaries for nurses in private hospitals in the Supreme Court in 2016, which then directed the government to fix the salary structure of the nurses. “However, as health is a state subject, only Kerala, Delhi, and Karnataka took note of it,” says George. “And it has since been partially followed only in Kerala.”

Others, like a large municipal corporation of Delhi hospital and a state-run hospital in Pune, have delayed salary disbursements during the pandemic.

IPNA has taken up cudgels on behalf of 84 temporary nurses who were fired by a well-known teaching hospital in Delhi, allegedly after they had protested that they had been denied Covid tests and adequate quarantine facilities on completion of

Covid duty. “One of the biggest private hospitals in Pune actually sent bouncers to nurses' quarters to intimidate them!” says Swati Rane of the Maharashtra chapter of Jan Swasthya Abhiyan, people's health movement. “We have to devise some way to regulate the treatment of nurses by private health care providers.”

Another source of insecurity for nurses working in private hospitals and nursing homes is the difficulty some have faced in getting treatment – and the problems that their bereaved families have encountered in their fight for compensation if they have died on duty. “Presently the government is only offering compensation to families of nurses who have died while serving in designated Covid hospitals,” says George.

This excludes those who have been infected in general wards, non-Covid hospitals and clinics. Families, including those of 46-year-old Ambika PK, who became the first nurse to die of Covid in Delhi, suffer endless wait for the compensation of ₹50 lakh that the government promised at the beginning of the pandemic. “Nurses are exhausted and demotivated,” says Jibin TC, state president of the Kerala-headquartered United Nurses' Association. “We've seen about 800 leave India during this pandemic for countries like the UK and UAE.”

India has only 1.7 nurses per 1,000 population against the World Health Organization norm of three per 1,000.

Govt identifies...

“It is true that there are very cumbersome procedures when it comes to sectors like retail, hotels, and entertainment, where they are required to fulfill multiple compliances. The government has given task to all the ministries and each one has reviewed the current framework. We have divided the whole exercise in five categories. The first one is to be done by the end of March, where we are aiming to reduce the annual inspection and digitising each data, are doing away with licence renewals or make it for longer period, and also looking at compiling multiple data into one,” said DPIIT Secretary Gurusprasad Mohapatra, while speaking at a panel discussion organised by Ficci on Friday.

Mohapatra said the department had received at least 200 suggestions from trade bodies and others on various regulations and Acts which were needed to be simplified or scrapped.

A study shows that on average, there are at least 2,000 compliance items that a company has to conform annually. Sectors like manufacturing have to comply with at least 6,000 items per year. Even industrialised states like Maharashtra and Gujarat have very high compliance requirements.

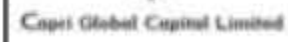
